Award of Merit:

This award will be presented to a Veterinarian, Registered Veterinary Technologist or a member of the community, who has made significant contributions to the veterinary profession, the NSVMA, the well being of animals, and who has enhanced the public image and public awareness of the veterinary profession.

★ Young Veterinarian Award:

This award will be presented to a recent graduate (2005 or later) who has made an outstanding contribution to the veterinary profession and his/her community.

★ The Dr. Hubert S. Bennett Award for Leadership in Veterinary Medicine:

Dr. Bennett practiced veterinary medicine in Nova Scotia for over 50 years and he is remembered for his long career of compassionate animal care. This award will be presented to a veterinarian who has a strong career of achievement and dedication to the profession.
